THE PREPARATION & INTERVIEW PHASE

Initial Briefing Information: You advised that you represent Brandon Woodruff in the Appeal of his conviction for Capital Murder in Hunt County, Texas, for which he received a sentence of Life without Parole on March 20, 2009. You provided for briefing purposes a copy of the Appellate Decision rendered by the Court of Appeals of Texas dated December 3, 2010 (No. 06-09-00086-CR). That decision reported the basis of the State's case, the evidence presented and argued by the parties; the Jury's Verdict; and the Court of Appeals findings.

In brief, Mr. Woodruff is convicted in the death of his parents Dennis and Norma Woodruff in their manufactured home located in Royce City, Texas on or about October 16, 2005. Mr. and Mrs. Woodruff died from gunshot wounds and multiple stab wounds. You advised that Mr. Woodruff has continuously denied that he had any part in the death of his parents and continues to maintain that he was not at his parent's residence and did not shoot or stab his parents. You requested that he be interviewed and tested to determine his truthfulness.

Pre-Test Interview with Examinee: The testing purpose, procedures, and requirements were explained and Mr. Woodruff expressed a desire to be questioned and examined.

Mr. Woodruff stated the weekend of October 16th he drove to the DFW area from Abilene Christian University (ACU) to visit his parents and friends and returned to ACU at the end of the weekend. Mr. Woodruff stated he stayed Friday and Saturday night at his parents' home in Heath, Texas. He described his activities on Sunday, October 16, 2005, stating he was in Royce City at Serenity Stables about 7:00 p.m.; then later he picked up friends and went clubbing until 1:30 to

2:00 a.m.; and drove back to ACU. Mr. Woodruff stated he did not kill his parents and was not present with them at the time they were killed.

THE TESTING PHASE

Test Objective: The relevant test questions noted below were designed to determine if Mr. Woodruff appears truthful when he denies killing his parents.

Test Procedure and Relevant Test Questions: A standardized, computerized polygraph examination was administered utilizing a standardized testing format. Noted below are the relevant-issue test questions asked during the testing phase and the examinee's test answers:

RELEVANT Q1: ARE YOU THE PERSON WHO SHOT AND/OR STABBED YOUR PARENTS?

ANSWER: NO

RELEVANT Q2: DID YOU DO ANY OF THE STABBING AND/OR SHOOTING OF YOUR PARENTS IN OCTOBER 2005?

ANSWER: NO

THE EVALUATION PHASE

Test Results: The direct examiner applied nationally recognized scoring criteria to evaluate the examination. The reliability of the test data was determined by additional evaluations of the charts, test questions, and scoring procedures. The conclusion from those evaluations is: **NO DECEPTION INDICATED.**

Professional Opinion Reported: The examinee's answers to the relevant test questions are considered to be: **TRUTHFUL.**
